### **REQUIREMENTS:**

- Experience supporting individuals with intellectual disabilities is an asset
  - The ability to read, write and speak English fluently is necessary
    - The ability to multitask, problem-solve and take initiative
      - Creativity and the ability to be resourceful
      - Excellent interpersonal and communication skills
      - The ability to maintain integrity in all situations
    - Knowledge of the Vulnerable Persons Act is an asset
- Must have current valid First Aid Certification prior to beginning work (if successful)
  - Valid Driver's License & Access to a vehicle is an asset
- **Successful applicants will be asked to provide a Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sector Search and both a Child and Adult Abuse Registry check upon hire at their own expense (with long processing times for these checks we encourage applicants to apply early – this will reduce wait time to begin employment).**
